APPLICATION FOR AWARDS

- 1. BULLETIN:** Clubs that enter this competition must submit at least three copies of three different issues of their bulletin to the Awards Committee no later than March 10, 2009. Clubs must publish and mail their bulletin at least once a month to qualify for the competition. Judging will follow National guidelines.
- 2. EXCHANGITE OF THE YEAR:** This award will be presented to the individual having the highest number of points for participation during the awards year.
- 3. YOUTH OF THE YEAR:** This award recognizes industrious high school students who attain high levels of scholastic achievement, community involvement and leadership.
- 4. ACE AWARD:** This award recognizes high school students who have made a dramatic change in their attitude and performance sometime during their high school years. These changes have enabled the student to overcome their adversities and prepare for graduation.
- 5. EXCHANGE CLUB OF THE YEAR:** This award is presented to the Club having the highest number of points earned on their Activity Summary Report entry form.
- 6. COMMUNITY SERVICE:** This award is given to the Clubs that presents the best community service based on the point system.
- 7. OUTSTANDING CLUB PRESIDENT:** This award will be presented in this category to the Club President receiving the highest number of points earned on their Activity Summary Report. This report must be signed by the Club Secretary certifying accuracy.

The District President will judge the following two awards. Documentation will be taken from information sent to the District Secretary and District President.

- 1. OUTSTANDING DISTRICT DIRECTOR**
- 2. OUTSTANDING DISTRICT COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN**

NATIONAL SERVICE AWARD

To win this award, a club must earn one patch in each of the four service areas (Youth, Americanism, Community Service, & Child Abuse Prevention) plus two additional projects. They also have to submit their PDM form to National. The PDM (Program Development Meeting) is held in July 2009.
